

A guide to identifying 1080 and pre feed baits coated with EPRO Deer Repellent.

With all of the 1080 operations in our area over the past season we have become aware of some confusion over the colour of baits coated in deer repellent.

The Epro Deer Repellent (EDR) coating on all 1080 bait is now green and was only ever brown during very initial trial work (in the early 2000's). All 1080 baits are now green and the dark green coating seen on the EDR coated 1080 baits in the pictures at the very bottom below has been the standard approach since the early 2000s.

The pre feed baits are brown as seen in the pictures below. Repellent is added to the pre feed baits in areas where repellent is to be added to 1080 baits as well, as it is important for the efficacy of the repellent to be on both prefeed and 1080 baits. The pre feed baits coated with EDR are dark brown as shown in the pictures below.
